### Kiwi's Corner

Happy New Year! A consistent golf swing and a consistent golf game is built on proper ALIGNMENT.

Check your alignment often. Pick a target and set up to the ball as normal, then place an alignment stick along the line of your toes, step back and see where it points. The alignment stick should point 2-3 feet parallel left of the target (for right-handed golfers). This is a square stance.

Knees, hips, and shoulders should also be in line with your feet. Have someone hold an alignment stick across your hips, your shoulders, and knees while you are in the set up position to check. Don't forget about the club face as you address the golf ball. This should be square (at right angles) to the ball-to-target line. Let's a have great 2018!

# TURF MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Weather summary...depressing! Over 12 inches of rainfall combined with multiple wind events made for a dreary, yet busy month. In spite of the weather, the bunker refresh project was completed on schedule. Sand, totaling 430 tons, was added to the bunkers and the heavy rainfall effectively compacted the new sand so there is little chance of fried-egg lies.

This month, the maintenance team will address several water issues; verti-drain work will resume on the fairways as conditions permit. Following periods of heavy rainfall, water pools on the second fairway of hole #17. This will be addressed by installing a dry-well in conjunction with the verti-drain to fracture the compacted soil beneath the fairway surface.

Throughout the year, but especially throughout the winter, turf maintenance works diligently to maintain healthy greens. Freezing conditions, excessive shade, and saturated conditions can contribute to turf decline if left unchecked. In an effort to promote healthy turf, trees are

preventatively pruned to improve light and air circulation. The greens are frequently aerated using needle tines which accelerate water and oxygen movement within the rootzone of the green. Prior to freezing conditions, topdressing sand is applied as an insulator. Finally, nutrients (fertilizers) are regularly applied to support healthy turf and fungicides are used to control turf disease if necessary.
