TURF TALK

Spring Has Arrived?

Unfortunately, we are enduring a prolonged winter this year in Western Washington. Frequent hail and snow showers into mid-April, accompanied by noticeably colder temperatures, has paused the spring surge. Although the weather is not great at present I am hopeful that we will rebound to better weather in May.

As a result of the colder weather pattern, the turf maintenance team has continued working on improving bunker edges and weeding the bunkers. With aerification completed, the greens are 100% healed, and the cutting height is being notched down every week. Over the next couple of weeks, the irrigation system will be pressurized so that Chris can begin checking the operational status of the system. Sprinkler operation is confirmed visually to ensure that they turn on and rotate properly. With approximately 1000 sprinklers on the golf course, it is essential to start the season 100% operational. Communication between the central computer and the satellites is also verified. The 29 irrigation satellites are cleaned and serviced. Seasonal staffing is also underway. Two new hires, Brayden and Michael have started working with the maintenance staff, and a third team member, Cole, will begin in mid-May. We are actively cross-training and coaching for daily maintenance practices. Thank you in advance for your patience, and we are looking forward to another great year at Indian Summer Golf and Country Club.

La Dominicana

Keeping with the Caribbean theme from last month, this is a good one to energize you and shake off the early spring chill. Created by Sasha Petraske from the iconic Milk & Honey in NYC.

Ingredients

- 1.5 oz. aged Dominican rum
- 1.5 oz. coffee liqueur
- Cream mix, to float (shake 5 parts heavy cream with 1 part milk and 2 sugar cubes)



Combine the aged rum and coffee liqueur in a shaker with ice. Shake until chilled, strain into a coupe, and float the cream over the top. Yum!
